Lord of heaven and earth, as Jesus taught his disciples to be persistent in prayer, give us patience and courage never to lose hope, but always to bring our prayers before you; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Post Communion Sentence.

God of our pilgrimage, you have willed that the gate of mercy should stand open for those who trust in you: look upon us with your favour that we who follow the path of your will may never wander from the way of life; through Jesus Christ our Lord.

In a couple of weeks time, on Sunday 8th September we will be welcoming the Bishop of Hertford the Right Reverend Dr Michael Beasley to a 10 am service and during the service Jake, Nicholas, Jonti, Bill, Laura, Neil, Sylvia and Gemma will be confirmed and Emma Louise will be received into the Church of England.

Confirmations are a really important part of the life of our parish. As well as supporting these nine candidates on their next steps in their faith journeys we also reflect on our own faith, and by welcoming the Bishop we see our parish in the context of the wider diocese and national church.

It means that the 10 am service will be a team service. There will not be any other services at 10 am (our 8 am, afternoon and evening services continue as usual). Even if you don't normally travel to another church, please make a special effort to join us at St Peter and St Paul's Tring for this service, and if you normally go to an 8 am service, maybe for this occasion you will have a lie in and come to the 10 am service. Please also think about offering lifts to others so that it is as easy as possible for as many of us as possible to attend.

In the service we will also remember the congregation of St Mary's Puttenham because the 8th September is one of the feast days of the Blessed Virgin Mary. You might like to go along to St Mary's for the service of light in the afternoon.
